THE HOLY ROSARY

WHAT

The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer reflecting on the life of Jesus and Mary while using Rosary beads.

The Rosary is made up of twenty "mysteries" or events in the life of Jesus and Mary. When praying a Rosary, you traditionally pray five of these mysteries that are divided into four groups as listed below:

- Joyful Incarnation to Early life
- Luminous Public Ministry
- · Sorrowful Passion and Death
- Glorious Resurrection of Jesus through Coronation of Mary

How

WAYS

- Start small for yourself or with young children by saying a decade (one event) a day.
- Come early for daily Mass to pray with your Church family or before the Sunday Masses.
- Pray daily, <u>5pm Virtual Zoom Rosary</u>.
- Pray a Family Rosary, Wed at 8:30 pm via Zoom.
- Pray a Rosary in the <u>Hallow app</u>.
- Pray a <u>Scriptural Rosary</u> where you read Bible passages between each Hail Mary.
- Join in our Living Rosary or Rosary processions offered at SSJ (look for details in the bulletin and Flocknote).



Pray the Rosary anytime - morning, afternoon, evening, or when you can not sleep in the middle of the night.

Our Lady calls us to pray the Rosary daily. Each day there is a suggested group of mysteries to pray:

- Joyful Mondays and Saturdays
- Sorrowful Tuesdays and Fridays
- · Glorious Wednesdays and Sundays
- · Luminous- Thursdays



You can pray the Rosary anywhere - at Church, at home, in the car, on a walk, or gathered at your prayer table.



The reasons to pray the Rosary are innumerable and the benefits eternal. May this short list inspire you to deepen your desire to pray the Rosary:

- Deepens your connection with Christ through Mary
- · Meditate on the life of Jesus
- · Deepen your faith
- · Gain grace and virtue
- · Find peace and calm

- Seek Mary's intercession
- · Keep your focus on the eternal
