## 2024 SSJ Holy Week Missions



## **Missions Descriptions**

- Door to Door Evangelizing our neighborhood: After a short door to door training, Family missionaries will walk
  within the neighborhood, go door to door sharing Christ's love with those you meet; reach out and evangelize our
  community promoting SSJ activities, Easter masses...etc.
- **Easter Basket** Families in needs support: Recollection of food donated by SSJ Parishioners during Lent, packing on Good Friday by missionaries, and home delivery on Holy Saturday to 75 families, praying with them.
- Sock and Shoes & Homeless Care Package Homeless Support: Recollection of socks and shoes, as well as food
  items during Lent donated by SSJ Parishioners. Sorting during Good Friday by missionaries, and delivery on Holy
  Saturday to the Homeless in Houston Downtown. For the 1<sup>st</sup> time this year, we will build and deliver a food care
  package to Homeless.
- Help the needy with Clothes (Guardian Angel Closet) Families in needs support: Recollection of clothes all year
  and during Lent, sorting of the SSJ closet on Good Friday. On Holy Saturday, missionaries will have an encounter
  with families to donate clothes at SSJ to approx. 20 families.
- Nursing home visits (Adopt a Grand Parent) Elderly Support: Missionaries will build 150 gifts in the Event Center
  on Good Friday morning. On Holy Saturday, missionaries will visit nursing homes with group of Youth and Families,
  play games, songs and have good time with our elderly community.
- Waterway Mission Evangelizing our neighborhood: On Holy Saturday, all youth and family missionaries will meet
  at the Woodlands Waterway and do a crosswalk, praying rosary and sing. Missionaries will request prayer intentions
  as we meet people and walk close to the waterway. The Waterway mission will finish at the waterway park for a
  closure event to share testimonies, play games, music and a surprise dinner. Mission 2018 on Vimeo
- Kids Track (PK-5<sup>th</sup> grade 5 to 11 years old): Activities specially organized for our youngest missionaries, drawing, singing, playing outside, movies, all about Easter, plus a special guided tour of the church. Kids Missions will have a special track and will have the opportunity to join kids' activities at church during the onsite missions time.
- Youth Track (Junior High + High schoolers 12 to 18 years old): Youth Missions will have a group of Junior High School and High School Boys and Girls that will be led by adults and priests. They will combine Service Missions with Evangelizing Missions and will have different talks specifically for youth. (Door to door at trailer park, visit to Nursing home, act Live station of the cross and special morning reflections). This year, High Schoolers will have 2 overnight missions at SSJ, both nights (Holy Thursday and Good Friday).

## • Other Missions at SSJ:

- o **Campus Clean-up -** Maintenance work will be planned at SSJ Parish for our missionaries from cleaning the yard, power washing some areas or setting up tables and doing general clean-up.
- Prayer Warriors: A missionary leader will guide mission prayers, pray the rosary and other prayers/reflections... it will take place at SSJ, the objective is to pray for missionaries' intentions, and for Holy Week. They will invite missionaries to pray all together.
- Hands with Heart: A group of ladies will help us to sew lovely hearts that will then be added in the Easter Basket and deliver to Homeless. It will take place in the Event Center on Good Friday 10-12pm.
